- If circumstances arise during GLOW that prevent staff from being able to adequately meet a youth's emotional or physical needs or the needs of other youth due to behaviours of the youth, we will be required to make arrangements for the youth to return home.
- We pledge to do our best to maintain optimal health and safety of all campers.
- We expect all campers to be free of head lice or otherwise infections.

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GLOW Program Rules

1. GLOW Program hours of operation are Monday to Friday from 9:30am to 5:15pm. The GLOW program is closed on holidays. Regular attendance is strongly encouraged to maintain your spot in the program.
2. All youth must remain in the GLOW space (upstairs at the Foster Family Coalition building) unless they have permission from the GLOW staff to enter other areas of the building.
3. All youth must demonstrate respectful behavior towards the GLOW and Foster Family Coalition staff, as well as other participants. This includes not swearing or using hurtful words towards others.
4. Vapes, weapons, alcohol, and drugs are not allowed in the Foster Family Coalition building. Youth who bring these items into the building will be asked to leave immediately and return only when they no longer have the item in their possession, and their caregivers will be notified.
5. Youth must participate in the GLOW programming while attending the program. This includes keeping phones in their pockets unless they have permission from staff to use their phones. Youth who do not participate will be asked to leave and return only when they are willing to participate in the program.
6. Youth are expected to help keep the GLOW space clean and to respect all Foster Family Coalition property. All participants must do their best to prevent any damages to the spaces and resources utilized while participating in the GLOW program.
7. Unwelcome physical contact, such as inappropriate touching, patting, pinching, punching, and physical assault is unacceptable.
8. Youth will not be permitted to participate in the GLOW programming if they are under the influence of alcohol, marijuana, or illegal substances.
9. Failure to respect the above noted rules will result in suspension from the GLOW program. A first time suspension will last one day and will increase for repeat offenses. Continued failure to respect the rules may result in permanent suspension.
